




### NSD 2016–17 Highlights

- 21 new agencies
- 1,398 school food authorities during annual updates
- CEP: 100 local educational agencies (LEA), 1,270 sites
- 86 courses at conferences
- 215 trainings and presentations
  - Including 12 DC regional trainings
- Over 31,000 attendees




#### CEP

- Allows high-needs schools to provide free breakfast and lunch to all students without collecting applications
- Schools are reimbursed based on the proportion of low income children in the school or district
- A district may implement community eligibility in one school, a group of schools, or districtwide



#### **CEP Benefits**

- Never collect meal applications
- Participation increases
- Can facilitate the implementation of Breakfast after the Bell modules
- Can improve the financial viability of the school nutrition department
- Overt identification and unpaid meal fees eliminated




### DC with Medi-Cal

#### Eligibility through Medi-Cal:

- Available statewide as of July 2017
- Certifies free and reduced-price meals
- Based on income, not Medi-Cal status
- Only available in CALPADS
- Benefits extend to all students in the



## School Meal Flexibilities SY 2017–18

#### Whole Grain-rich Requirement


State agencies may offer exemptions from the whole grain-rich requirements

#### Sodium Limits

Schools must continue to meet Target 1 sodium requirements

#### Low-fat, Flavored Milk

### Modifications to Accommodate Disabilities


- After the passage of the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendments Act, most physical and mental impairments constitute a disability



- Electronic signatures are acceptable
- State licensed healthcare professionals are allowed to complete and sign a written medical statement for a disability:
  - —Licensed physician
  - Physician assistant
  - Nurse practitioner



### **LSWP Final Rule: 2016**

Implementation was required by June 30, 2017

- Specific goals for student wellness, including nutrition education and promotion
- Nutrition standards for all foods on campus
- Food and beverage marketing
- Annual notification and triennial assessments
- LEA oversight



## SNP Annual Reviews: LSWP is Under General Area


- SY 2017–18 and 2018–19:
  - Fully comply except for triennial assessment
- SY 2019–20:
  - Assess and update (triennial assessment)

## **SNP Reimbursement**Rates SY 2017–18






## FDP Rate Changes (SY 2018–19)

Fee Type	Rate per case/unit	New Rate per case/unit
USDA Foods delivered by a state distribution center (SDC)	\$2.60	\$2.85
USDA Foods picked up by agency from an SDC	\$2.20	\$2.40
USDA Foods sent to processor or distributor (Administrative fee)	\$0.80	\$0.90
Department of Defense (DoD) and Pilot produce received directly (Administrative Fee)	\$0.10	\$0.15


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## Local Agency Procurement Review

#### **Overview**

- Beginning SY 2017–18
- Implementing full local agency procurement review
- Conducting in 3- and 6-year cycles



### **Procurement Review Tool**

 The USDA developed a tool to assess program operators procurement procedures and practices:



- Code (standards) of conduct
- Procurement procedures
- Procurement documentation
  - Solicitation
  - Evaluation and award
  - Contract management
  - Invoices and receipts




