

Level 1 Certificate

Step 1

 Complete an 8 hour Nutrition Education Core Course

Step 2

 Complete an 8 hour Food Safety & Sanitation Core Course

Step 3

- Submit to SNA:
 - Completed application form
 - Payment
 - Copies of all required certificates of completion

Note: You do NOT need to provide a copy of your high school diploma or GED



Level 2 Certificate



- COMPLETE THE CORE REQUIREMENTS
 - 8 hour Nutrition Education Core Course
 - 8 hour Food Safety & Sanitation Core Course

Step 2

- COMPLETE THE KEY AREA REQUIREMENTS
 - 20 hours in Key Area 1 Operations
 - 15 Hours in Key Area 2 Nutrition, Education
 & Physical Activity
 - 20 Hours in Key Area 3 Administration
 - 15 Hours in Key Area 4 Marketing/Communications

Level 2 Certificate (cont...)



- Submit to SNA:
 - Completed application form
 - Payment
 - Copies of all required certificates of completion
 - A copy of your high school diploma/ GED

Level 3 Certificate – Option A



 High School Diploma / General Equivalency Diploma (GED)



- COMPLETE THE COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS
 - 3 College Credits in Key Area 1 Operations
 - 3 College Credits in Key Area 2 Nutrition, Education & Physical Activity
 - 3 College Credits in Key Area 3 Administration AND Key Area 4 – Marketing/Communications





Level 3 Certificate – Option A



- Submit to SNA:
 - Completed application form
 - Payment
 - A copy of your high school diploma/ GED
 - Copies of your college transcripts

Notes: You do MUST submit a copy of your high school diploma or GED. Unofficial college transcripts will be accepted.



Level 3 Certificate – Option B



- COMPLETE THE CORE REQUIREMENTS
 - 8 hour Nutrition Education Core Course
 - 8 hour Food Safety & Sanitation Core Course

Step 2

COMPLETE THE KEY AREA REQUIREMENTS

- 35 hours in Key Area 1 Operations
- 35 Hours in Key Area 2 Nutrition, Education & Physical Activity
- 45 Hours in Key Area 3 Administration AND Key Area 4 – Marketing/Communications
- 15 hours in General Electives (any of the four Key Areas)

Level 3 Certificate – Option B



- Submit to SNA:
 - Completed application form
 - Payment
 - Copies of all required certificates of completion
 - A copy of your high school diploma/ GED

Important FYIs

- Core Requirement courses cannot date back further than five years of the date you apply.
- College courses can be used regardless of how many years ago they were completed




• Key Area hours completed by attending programs/ workshops cannot date back further than five years from the date you apply and must have at least 2 hours of active instructional time.

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Academic Requirement	Key Area Hours Requirement	Work Experience Requirement

Exam Content and Knowledge Areas

- Facilities, Technology and Equipment Management 5%
- Financial Management **16**%
- Food Production and Operation Management 15%
- Food Security, Sanitation, & Safety 14.5%
- Human Resource Management 10%
- Marketing and Communication 7%
- Menu and Nutrition Management 17%
- Procurement and Inventory Management 5.5%
- Program Management and Accountability 10%



Getting the Exam Results

• Results: in 6 to 8 weeks after exam




• Pass: (score of 78.5% or higher) use the SNS designation after your name, receive an SNS Certificate and are able to order the SNS Pin

 Didn't Pass: receive a letter and Diagnostic Report showing the areas of weakness in the exam
