

- Update your Resume'
- Evaluate job opportunities & highlight your skills on your resume' that match.
- Example: Management skills or Supervisory skills- did you manage a restaurant, a store or catering company ? Did you schedule, evaluate, supervise or manage people?
- Office skills Email= typing skills, Microsoft Word, Excel, Power Point skills. Filing, budgeting, phone skills & customer service is very important.
