Enhance and Improve Student Support Programs, Interventions, and Enrichment Opportunities in the areas of:

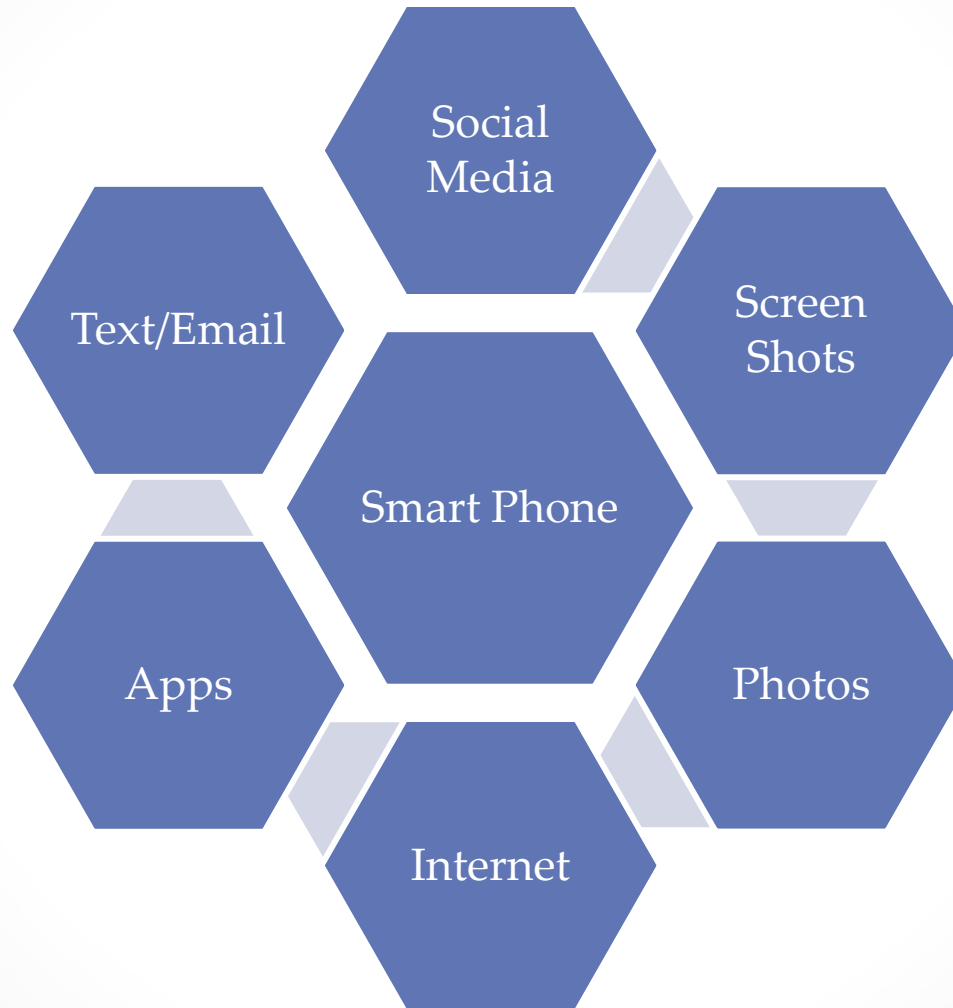

Implement effective Professional Development for all staff based on District priorities and staff/site needs

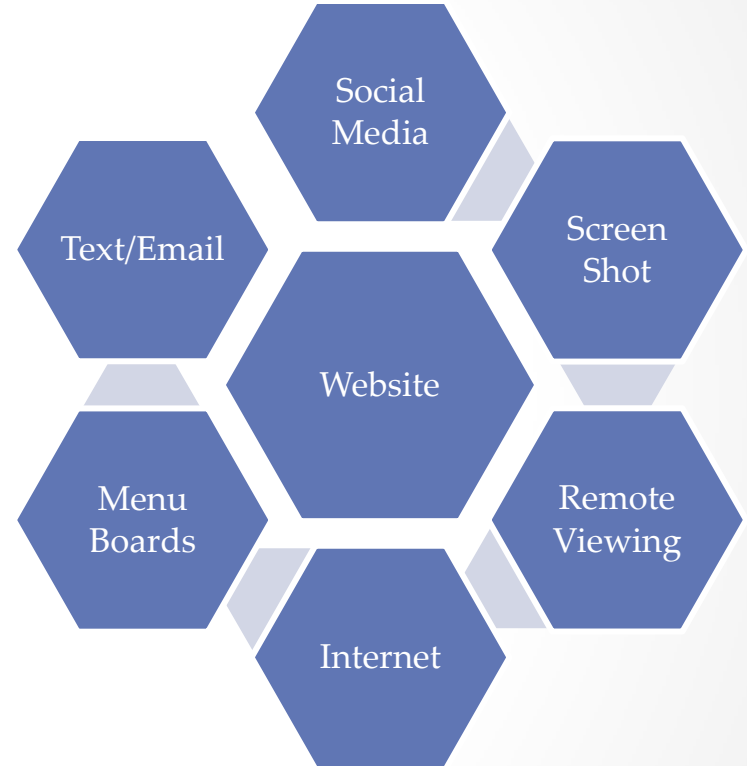
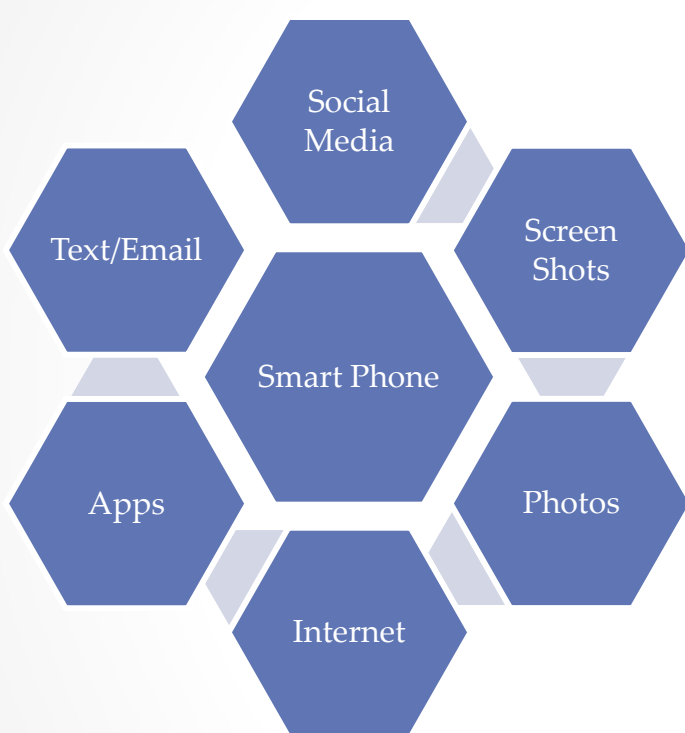
Embrace Student, Family, Community, Business, and Non-Profit Partnerships that are positive and align to the goals and priorities of OMSD

Hi Sara,


Digital menu boards are an allowable expense as long as the item is used exclusively by the nonprofit school food service and will not be used by any other party. If a school food service does not abide by this will result in the entire item of cost being disallowed and the LEA's general fund reimbursing the nonprofit school food service account.

1. Title 7 Code of Federal Regulations Section 210.14(a), "Resource management"

Nonprofit school food service. School food authorities shall maintain a nonprofit school food service. Revenues received by the nonprofit school food service shall be used for the **operation or improvement of such food service, except that,** such revenues shall not be used to purchase land or buildings, unless otherwise approved by the LEA.

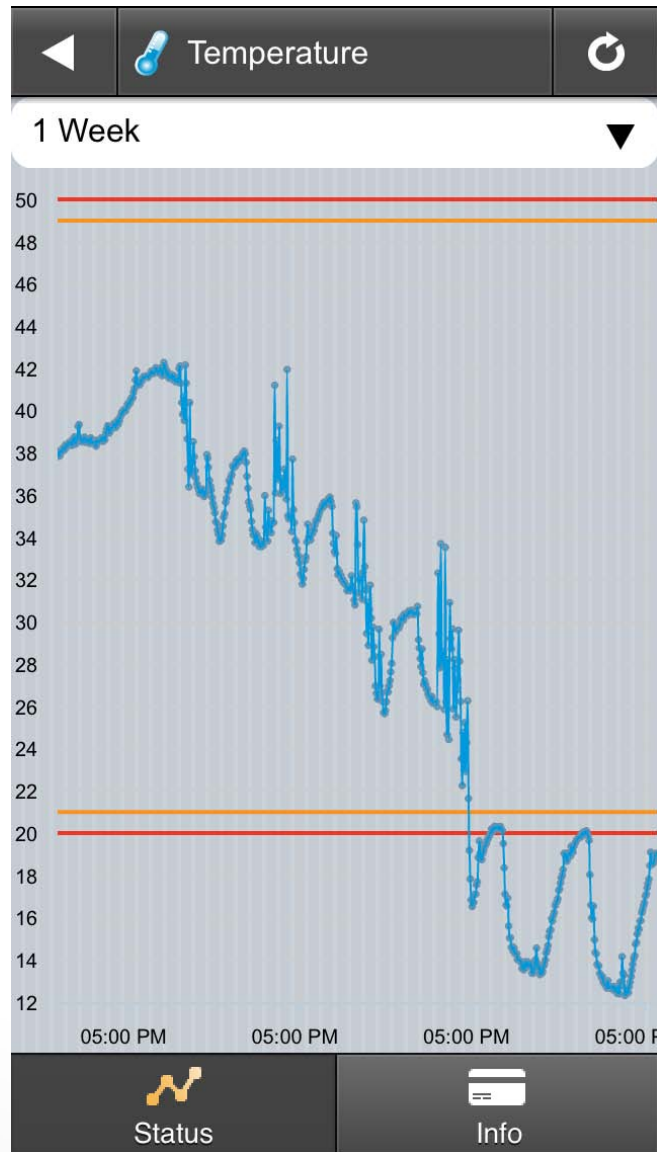
