The Rose Bowl Stadium was built in 1922 and held its first game in October, that same year. It is referred to as the "Granddaddy of Them All" because of its prestige and tradition. The Rose Bowl is the 16th largest stadium in the world and the 11th largest stadium in the United States. It will be a one and a half hour guided tour. In addition to the kitchen, we will get to see the working press box, the court of Champions, the playing field and more!



Our tour guide will tell us the history of all the great events that have taken place in this magnificent stadium like the countless Rose Bowl Games, the Super Bowls, and even Football (Soccer here in the USA!) at the 1984 Olympics! It is the home stadium for the UCLA Football team and has hosted countless concerts over the years with acts such as The Rolling Stones, Metallica, Ed Sheeran, just to name a few. It also hosted Depeche Mode for what is widely touted as their greatest live performances.

 $\mathcal{R}$ egistration is now open for the SNS Credentialing Exam. This year, the SNS exam will be offered on

Thursday October 20, 2022, from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm. Now is the time to think about taking the exam as you will want to take a couple of months to study and prepare. Earning the credential of SNS is well worth the effort, as adding the credential to your signature, is a way to indicate your commitment and proficiency in all things School Nutrition.

Registration is done on the School Nutrition Website and is \$225 for SNA members and \$325 for Non-Members. The deadline to register is Thursday September 29, 2022. While you are on the SNA web site, be sure to check out all the great SNS exam resources they offer such as a handbook that thoroughly describes the SNS exam process and there is a SNS exam study guide that is available for purchase.
