## Proposed Professional Standards for State and Local School Nutrition Programs Personnel Required by the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010

## **Purpose:**

- Establish a program of mandatory education, training, and certification for all food nutrition directors responsible for the management of a school food authority
- Require that each SFA ensures that local nutrition personnel complete annual training and receive annual certification to demonstrate competence
- Establish criteria and standards for States to use in the selection of State agency directors with responsibility for the National School Lunch
  Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP)
